Who's eligible

- All California State University, San Bernardino College international students and scholars:
 - Under the age of 65
 - With a current passport and an F-1 or J-1 visa
 - Who are temporarily residing outside their Home Country while actively engaged in education or educational activities, OPT or research related activities at the Policyholder
 - Spouse and Domestic Partners of the above eligible students
 - Dependent child(ren) of the above eligible students
- Students taking the following courses are not eligible to enroll in the insurance plan: distance learning courses; students solely taking off-campus internet, home study, correspondence, or television courses; courses taken for audit.
